from **Customer Conduct Policy**  
Board Reviewed/Approved February 23, 2016

The following Rules of Conduct will be posted in each library:

1. Bags and other items may be searched.
2. Disruptive behavior (loud, boisterous talking or activity, running, excessive smells, abusive language, harassing behavior, eating or any behavior that disrupts the legitimate use of the library) is not permitted.
3. Smoking or use of tobacco products is not permitted on library property.
4. Food and drink are permitted only in designated areas or in meeting rooms.
5. Library equipment, property, and facilities may be used for intended purposes only.
6. Cooperative behavior and compliance with all library policies and requests by staff are expected.
7. Romantic displays of affection are inappropriate.
8. Theft or vandalism of library property will result in notification of police.
9. Unattended children are not the responsibility of the library.
10. Cell phones should be silenced in quiet zones.
11. Personal electronic equipment may be used if not disturbing to others.
12. Shirts and shoes are required.
13. Sales and solicitations are not permitted.
14. Operating roller skates, skateboards or other personal sporting equipment on library property is not permitted unless part of a library-sponsored program.
15. Animals are not permitted except service animals or those that are part of a library-sponsored presentation.
