Starting in January, <u>FREE</u> unlimited 24/7 music streaming is available through Freegal Music+ and your library card! You also can continue to download and keep up to five songs a week for free!

Freegal Music+ allows library cardholders to access a collection spanning over 18 million songs from more than 93,000 music labels worldwide. Freegal also offers a free mobile app available for library cardholders, downloadable in the Apple App Store, Google Play store and Amazon.
