For the little ones, get ready for Summer Explorers Story Time. There will be books, music, crafts and a lot of fun.

The entire family will enjoy the return of Terrific Tuesdays, which kicks off with Honey Hill Farm Petting Zoo, then contin-

ues with Science Heroes: Adventure of the Missing Color, K9 Heroes: A Day with Officer Cannon and K9 Siri, Jeff Nicholas Art, Musical Conexion Family Concert and The Professor Show.

Two shows each day, one at 2 p.m. at the Lawrenceburg Civic Park and 6 p.m. at North Dearborn Branch Library. (But the 2 p.m. petting zoo will be at the Lawrenceburg Main Library.)

Everyone also is welcome to participate in Wilderness Survival 101 with instructor Clint Jivoin Saturday, June 14, at the North Dearborn Branch Library.

Learn how to prepare for a trip into the great outdoors, from what gear to bring to how to plan ahead in case of emergencies. Survival skills demonstrated will include building shelters and fires, as well as how to find food and drinkable water in the wilderness.

There are book clubs for school-age kids along with Tech & Treats. This year kids will take turns making healthy snacks and creating items on our 3D printer.

Teens get ready to create junk journals, create a paint-by-numbers masterpiece, join the

Anime Club for a craft hour or create a crayon canvas.

Adults (and sometimes teens too) also have a variety of programs to choose from including Container Herb Gardening, Marbling, Colors of the Cosmos, a program on Morgan's Raid, DIY Owl Paver Décor, diamond art, a presentation on the colorful history of Indiana's county courthouses and an Intro to Craft Beer (sorry teens, you are not invited to this one.)

There also will be story hunts in June and July at both libraries and the Mobile Library will be visiting the Farmers Market in Downtown Lawrenceburg.

Stop by the Lawrenceburg Main Library for the rules to the Summer LEGO Challenge. Create a scene to fit the Color Our World theme for a chance at a prize!
